Kevin Harrang is a Director of MetaJure, Inc.

Before joining MetaJure, Kevin worked at Microsoft Corporation for 18 years and served as a former Deputy General Counsel, Associate General Counsel, Senior Corporate Attorney and Corporate Attorney in the Legal and Corporate Affairs Division.

At Microsoft, Kevin was in-house intellectual property counsel for consumer and online business groups; member of client business leadership teams, and responsible for counseling officers and senior executives on legal and business strategies. Kevin led high level business negotiations for commercial transactions and acquisitions; was the senior leader of 20-50 person teams of attorneys and paralegals supporting business groups; and a member of General Counsel's Management Team and departmental Diversity Team. Kevin ran the large (40+ person) departmental operations group reporting directly to General Counsel, and was responsible for business management, information systems and resources, and finance & accounting. Duties included legal practice systems, business process re-engineering, and outside counsel management.

Kevin managed the IT team that developed and implemented transformational changes, including 100% paperless electronic billing system for outside counsel, department-wide matter management system, corporate wide email management system beta, and inaugural preferred provider network for Microsoft outside counsel (annual budget in excess of \$300M, with achieved savings of \$40M).

Kevin formerly was an associate attorney in the business group at Preston Gates & Ellis specializing in computer law and commercial transactions.

Kevin also served as an aide to Honorable James Weaver (D-Oregon) a United States House of Representatives, in Washington DC.
