Rich Corbett is President and CEO of MetaJure, Inc.

With more than 15 years of experience in business and law, Rich has a background as both a practicing attorney and a successful entrepreneur. Rich was the founder of Applied Discovery, Inc., a pioneer in online legal electronic discovery. As Chief Operating Officer, he worked with the executive team to establish all business operations and demonstrated year-over-year revenue growth in excess of 100% and net operating margins in excess of 20% for a 5-year duration. During his tenure, Rich received the Ernst & Young Northwest Regional Award for "Entrepreneur of the Year" in 2003, and Applied Discovery was awarded several prestigious business awards including the Washington Software Alliance "Service Provider of the Year" award. Applied Discovery was acquired by LexisNexis and renamed LexisNexis Applied Discovery. Following the acquisition, Rich served as COO of LexisNexis Applied Discovery, where he was responsible for the successful post-acquisition integration of the company.

Prior to joining MetaJure, Rich was Principal and Executive Producer with Rich Corbett Productions, LLC, the independent film production company responsible for the award-winning *Nine Winters Old*, winner of the 2007 Mountain Culture Award at the Banff Mountain Film Festival and the 2007 Mountain Culture Award at the Mountainfilm in Telluride Film Festival.

Rich began his career as an attorney, and previously served as corporate counsel for Mosaix, Inc., which was later acquired by Lucent Technologies. He also worked as a commercial litigation attorney at Perkins Coie LLP. His legal experience began as a clerk in the Seattle Municipal Court system.

Rich has been a frequent speaker and author on various topics related to law, business and technology. His education includes a BA, *magna cum laude*, from Seattle University and a JD from Franklin Pierce Law Center in New Hampshire.
